

Stryker Scores At Wigan

Stryker Communications, the specialist wireless surveillance system provider, has signed four new players for Wigan Metropolitan Borough Council in UK



Under the recently completed deal, **Stryker** are supplying its new generation **IRIS** (Intelligent Remote Information System) wireless CCTV surveillance systems to help combat crime across the borough.

These new cameras are equipped with digital COFDM transmission to enable high-quality, real-time images to be obtained even in heavily built-up areas where there is no clear line-of-sight to the receiving location. The new signings were unveiled recently at Wigan Council's Community Protection department HQ at Westwood Park, Wigan.



Commenting on the systems, Councillor Keith Cunliffe, Cabinet Member for Community Protection at Wigan MBC, said: "We're investing £75,000 in the new cameras, but we expect a serious return on our investment in terms of identifying the criminals, persistent trouble-makers and fly-tippers who blight our borough"

The council is also taking advantage of Stryker's **trade-in** programme which allows existing wireless camera equipment to be traded in against Stryker's new generation of products.
